The New Hampshire Lakes Region Model A Club has arranged to receive and park your Model A awaiting your arrival. Your 'A' will be awaiting your arrival before your short drive to North Conway.

We will be receiving Model As via your transport trucking company starting five (5) days prior to the start of the tour or between the dates of Monday, June 14th through Friday, June 18th. No one will be available to receive your car after this date.

If you are shipping your 'A' back after the tour you will need to return it to the same address. Please note that you will need to arrange for pickup between the following dates: Monday June 28th through Friday July 2nd.

Model A storage will be outside on private property. A NLRMAC member knowledgeable of the operation of Model A's will assist in the unloading and loading of your Model A. MAFCA, NHRMAC or Vintage Antique Classic Cars will not be liable for any damage if, incurred while being unloaded, stored and reloaded for return shipment.

Boston Logan Boston International Airport, Boston, MA to Melvin Village	113 miles
Portland International Jetport, Portland, ME to Melvin Village	61 miles

TOURS

#1 Mount Washington Valley

This tour will take you north from North Conway where you will travel through many small New Hampshire towns like Jackson, home of the **Honeymoon Covered Bridge**. From there you will travel to **The Mount Washington Auto Road**. The Auto Road is a thrilling ride up over 6,000 feet to the summit where you'll take in views of Maine, Vermont, Massachusetts, Canada and the Atlantic Ocean. The view stretches for 100s of miles on a clear day. From Mount Washington Auto Road you will continue north to Gorham, NH and around Mt. Adams through the beautiful White Mountains. On this tour you will visit **The Cog Railway** which also travels up Mt. Washington and you can have lunch at the historic **Mount Washington Hotel**. A few covered bridges and many wonderful sights are waiting for you.

#2 Route 153, Museums and Wolfeboro, NH

On this tour you will see more wonderful New England vistas. You will spend a short time traveling in Maine before returning to New Hampshire where you'll see many New Hampshire lakes and can visit interesting museums. Wolfeboro is America's first summer resort with many opportunities to shop and find a place for lunch. You can visit the **New Hampshire Boat Museum**, **The Wright World War Two Museum**, and **The Libbey Natural History Museum** and visit the **Castle in the Clouds** in Moultonborough, NH and see spectacular Lake Winnepesaukee views.



#3 Kancamagus Highway, On Golden Pond

National Scenic Byway with the tongue-twister name – the **Kancamagus Highway** is New England's most superb scenic drive. This tour will take you on the "Kanc", as it is known to the locals, with river views, covered bridges and wonderful mountain vistas. Then head south to Holderness, NH where **Squam Lake** is located. This is where scenes of "On Golden Pond" were filmed. Take a lake tour, visit the **Natural Wildlife Center** or do both. Then explore the quaint village of Sandwich.

#4 Kennebunk Highlight Tour

Kennebunk was established in 1736 and has a significant number of late 18th and early 19th century houses from the period when Kennebunk was a shipbuilding and maritime shipping center. The **Historic District of Kennebunk** begins in the center of town and follows Route 35 to Kennebunkport. Some examples of early architecture that you will pass as you drive through the Historic District are: Colonial, Federal, Greek Revival, Italianate, and Queen Anne. Examples of the **many** beautiful historic homes are below.
