The Judging Standards Committee (JSC) is seeking people who love the Model A Ford and have the desire and skills to serve on the JSC. The JSC is one of the most important groups affecting the future of the Model A Ford hobby. The purpose of the JSC is:

- Develop, maintain and coordinate the process and procedures for judging Model A Fords at National Conventions and other MAFCA sanctioned judging events.
 - Maintain, coordinate, publish and update the *Model A Restoration Guidelines & Judging Standards* in conjunction with the Model A Restorer's Club (MARC).
 - Coordinate, maintain, standardize and update the Model A Ford Judge Certification Program including the judge testing program.
- Establish and maintain a set of minimum requirements that each Model A vehicle shall meet as a prerequisite for admittance to the various classes of judging.
 - Develop, maintain and update a judging awards system for Model A vehicles at National Conventions and other MAFCA sanctioned judging events

There will be three vacancies next year, which represents a significant change in the makeup of the committee. There are six members on the committee. One of the six is the Chief Judge for the next National Convention.

We are seeking knowledgeable individuals who are willing to perform research and write about the Model A to help the hobby. Travel to face-to-face meetings is required.
