



## Area 7 - Brake System



**INCLUDES:** brake and clutch pedals, service and emergency brake cross shafts, backing plates, rods, actuating levers, drums, reinforcing bands (if any), correctness and working order. Hydraulic braking systems through 1948, are allowed.

**DOES NOT INCLUDE:** emergency brake handle, stop light switch or light(s).

**TOTAL POINTS:** 15

### GENERAL

Finish and workmanship, including plating, should be foremost in judging. For authenticity of the various components judged here, refer to the current Model A Restoration Guidelines and Judging Standards. A good reproduction part shall receive 50% of the points for that item, but a modern part (after 1948) will receive 0 points.
