



Area 18 - Lamps

INCLUDES: working order, cowl lamps, fender lamps, rear lamps, mounting bar, arms and brackets, lens condition and correctness, reflector plating and correctness, bulbs and switches.

DOES NOT INCLUDE: correctness of plating or finish of the lamps, light switch handle, correctness of wiring, instrument panel lamp, or dome lamp.

TOTAL POINTS: 15

GENERAL

Finish, workmanship, plating, materials and correctness should be foremost in judging. For authenticity of the various components judged in this area, refer to the current Model A Restoration Guidelines and Judging Standards. A good reproduction part shall receive 50% of the points for that item, but a modern part (after 1939) will receive 0 points.
